## 2018-19 SCHOOL PROFILE

### SCHOOL

Turlock Christian High School is an independent, private, non-denominational, co-education Christian high school. The student enrollment is 158 in grades nine through twelve. There is a 1:15 teacher-student ratio.

### FACULTY

The high school staff is made up of twenty full-time and part-time teachers. Instructors participate in ongoing staff development which includes content area and instructional methods. Additionally, TC offers extensive online and dual credit courses.

### CURRICULUM

There are seven class periods meeting every other day for a total of over 64,800 minutes of instructional time. The minimum graduation requirements are 250 credits for grades nine through twelve. Each class receives five credits per semester. Each semester is an accumulation of two nine-week quarters.

### CURRICULUM (Continued)

Turlock Christian High School provides the general education that is the basis for college preparation and future employment. Students following a college preparatory plan meet University of California entrance requirements.

Turlock Christian has an Agriculture Department which provides students the opportunity to follow an FFA pathway in Ag Chemistry, Ag Biology, Ag Government, Ag Economics, Ag Business, Ag Leadership, Ag Sales & Marketing, and plant and animal field experience.

### COLLEGE READINESS

Turlock Christian High School prepares its students academically for college with 97% of last year's seniors attending a university/college and 92% of the 2017 graduates being accepted to a 4-year university/college.

### SAT

70% of our Turlock Christian High School 2018 graduates took the SAT averaging a score of 596 on the SAT English section and 603 on the SAT Math section for a total of 1196. 92% met the English benchmark set by SAT as being prepared for college.

## COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENT

Students are required to complete a total of 105 community service hours to fulfill Turlock Christian's graduation requirement. These hours are to be completed in established increments for each grade level as follows:

Freshmen	20 hours (10 hours required per semester)
Sophomores	25 hours (12.5 hours required per semester)
Juniors	30 hours ( 15 hours required per semester)
Seniors	30 hours (15 hours required per semester)

## GRADING, GPA, RANKING

GPA is based on a 4.0 scale (A=4; B=3; C=2; D=1; F=0). Grades of C or higher in Honors and AP Courses earn an additional grade point. Grades are reported by semester. **Turlock Christian does not rank.**

**\*Beginning with the class of 2021, 2 years of Language other than English will be required for graduation.**
