### SUMMER EAGLE DAY CAMP—Located at Turlock Christian Elementary School

#### Tuesday, May 30 - Friday, August 4 - 7:00 AM-6:00 PM

**PURPOSE:** To provide elementary students who have finished kindergarten through fifth grade with a wide variety of activities and experiences to broaden their perspective of the world around them. The program brings a wholesome, enriched summer environment for children who have completed Kindergarten-5th Grade by May, 2023. Students will participate in a variety of activities such as art, crafts, cooking, story time, movies, music, computer, Bible stories, and educational activities. Enrollment is limited. Students will be enrolled on a first come - first served basis.

**HOURS:** 9am to 4pm. However, students who have working parents may come as early as 7am and stay as late as 6pm, with supervised care at no extra charge. Parents will be charged an additional \$1 per minute for pick-ups after 6:00 pm.

**FIELD TRIPS:** Plans are to have a few off campus field trips during our 10-week program. Students can participate in field trips if they are enrolled in at least two days of Summer Eagle Day Camp, including Friday trip participation will be on a space available basis. **The cost for each field trip is an additional charge and is to be paid in advance.** Students will travel by school vans and/or approved parent volunteer drivers to various points of interest throughout Central California.

# TCS Summer Enrichment FAQ

Unless noted below, all elementary classes are located at the Elementary Campus

## **Can I Take Advantage of Summer Enrichment Classes and Summer Eagle Day Camp?**

Yes! For elementary students, they can go from Day Camp to a Summer Enrichment Class (or two) and then back to Day Camp. See Pricing Options for this. One registration fee of \$75 will be due to register for both programs per child.

## **When can I register?**

As soon as possible. Spots are filled on a first come, first served basis.

## **How can I register?**

Turn this completed packet in to the TCS Elementary office, in person (2323 Colorado Ave., Turlock, CA), or by mail (Mailing address: PO Box 1540, Turlock, CA 95381). You can also email your application to [sbuchanan@turlockchristian.com](mailto:sbuchanan@turlockchristian.com).

## **Will I be sent a confirmation?**

Yes. We will send you an email confirmation as soon as we complete your student's enrollment. If there is not space available in a program/class you have chosen, you will be notified. There is a minimum number of 10 students who must be enrolled in order for a class to be held. The decision whether or not to cancel a class will be made one week before the start date and is based on the number of paid fees on that date. We will notify you accordingly.

## **Financial Procedures**

All Enrichment Class and Day Camp Payments will be made through FACTS, our online payment system. Once your application is processed an account will be set up for you through our business office. Once you choose your desired schedule for Eagle Day Camp, that schedule becomes firm for the summer. You can add days if space permits. Because staffing is determined by enrollment, you will be billed for the days you choose. A 30 day notice to drop days or withdraw from the program is required. You will receive monthly billing statements from FACTS. If you have chosen the weekly payment option, the fees will be calculated by adding the weeks together.

## **Where will the summer activities be held?**

Summer Eagle Day Camp and Summer Enrichment Classes will be held at the Elementary Campus (2323 Colorado Ave., Turlock)

## **Does my student need to be signed in and out?**

Yes. When your student arrives to their room/location there will be a sign in/sign out sheet. Please make sure you sign in and out when your children come and arrive.

## **What grade level should my student sign up for?**

Sign your children up for the grade they will be entering in the fall. If your student is now finishing 6th grade, he/she should look at **Summer Enrichment** classes for 7th graders. Please contact the Jr./Sr. High office. **Summer Eagle Day** Camp welcomes children who have finished kindergarten through 6th grade.

## **Is there a Dress Code?**

Yes. No spaghetti straps, no short-shorts. No shirts that show a mid-section. K-6: Flip flops need to have a sturdy sole for playground use. Bathing suits need to be one piece. Comfortable clothes and shoes, appropriate for the activity/field trip they are participating in is requested.

## **Behavior Policy**

All Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that demonstrates courtesy and respect for others and to the facilities. Disruptive students will be issued a behavior form with an expectation of positive cooperation. If inappropriate behavior continues, parents will be contacted to pick them up. If disruptive behavior continues, the student will be dismissed from the program with no refund. Please review this behavior policy with your student prior to the first day of camp.

## **Refund Policy**

Registration fees are non-refundable unless Turlock Christian cancels a Summer Enrichment class due to low enrollment. Refunds for Summer Enrichment courses will be granted anytime 7 days before the start of each course (minus \$20 fee). Because of supplies that must be ordered, we cannot give refunds after 7 days of the course start date. Please plan accordingly.





# TCS Summer Enrichment Course Descriptions

**Art:** Join us for arts and crafts enrichment class! We will keep those imaginations busy with two weeks of creativity, exploration and more. Art class will include a variety of mediums and an array of projects such as self-portraits, pointillism, abstract, mosaics and so much more! **Grades 1-3 and 4-6.** Teacher: Ms. Sarah Bakker

**Drama: Grades 1st - 3rd** Students will build confidence while learning about improv, public speaking activities, stage set-up, singing, dancing and various acting activities. Students will put on a small drama production for the TCS Summer camp at the end of the session. Teacher: Ms. Jessica Starling

**Drama: Grades 4th - 6th** Students will build confidence while learning about improv, public speaking activities, stage set-up, singing, dancing and various acting activities. Students will work on memorization and reading skills by doing table reads of various scripts. Students will put on a small drama production for the TCS Summer camp at the end of the session. Teacher: Ms. Jessica Starling

**Jr. Eagles Sports Camp:** This camp will consist of learning the fundamental skills of soccer, softball, kickball, track and field events (hurdles, relay races, long jump), and golf - putting skills. No equipment/special gear is needed. Just work out shoes and a positive attitude!

**Lego Education/Mindstorms Robotics Lab Grades 3 and 4** Campers will have fun building robots and learning to program it's movements. Our camp will use Lego Education resources to create robots and program the robots movements using block coding. Students who enjoyed programming lessons in Code.org and are looking for a hands-on experience will enjoy this camp session.

**Lego Education/Mindstorms Robotics Lab Grades 5 and 6** Campers will have fun building robots and learning to program it's movements. Our camp will use Lego Education resources to create robots and program the robots movements using block coding. TC students in grades 5 and 6 are prepared for the programming challenge based on their experience this academic year. Students looking for a hands-on experience will enjoy this creative exploration of robotics. Select students will be invited to train as robotics leaders for the 3rd/4th grade camp.

**Mathletes: Grades 4 - 6** This class will be an opportunity to review and practice the "foundation of computation" in math accuracy and speed. We will have training sessions with work-outs and strengthening sessions to practice speed and endurance in the area of math. Students will also increase their writing fluency through daily writing prompts and activities.
