All of you mean so much to me. I'm forever grateful for the teachers and friends who encouraged me and prayed for me when I needed support and kindness the most.

Today, I'm giving my life fully to Jesus Christ. This is something I've wanted to do with my sister for a long time, and I'm so excited to finally be baptized and follow Him with all my heart.***
