This accomplishment places TC not only among the elite in sportsmanship but also reflects intentional leadership, high expectations, and a deeply rooted culture of respect and integrity.

In a system with strict policies—such as suspensions for player or coach ejections, and even yellow/red card warnings for adult spectators—it's remarkable that TC navigated an entire athletic calendar free from disciplinary incidents. That's not luck—it's deliberate, values-driven work: embodying **Victory with Honor** and shaping students holistically, both on and off the field. Congratulations to our AD, Nicole Rodrigues, for her leadership!

That's **you**—the coaches, parents, administrators—demonstrating leadership, reinforcing character, and living our mission. Every action—sharing a story, mentoring a student, modeling respectful behavior—echoes beyond today and ripples into the broader culture at TC. With that in mind:
